PRESENTATION OF THE VISITS

• **Fautras factory** - Thursday 10th May on the Morning

For more than 25 years and from generation to generation, the FAUTRAS brand is No. 1 in Europe thanks to its know-how and innovations regularly rewarded. Horse dealers and riders, FAUTRAS family got specialized in manufacturing vans thanks to a daily contact with horses. Since its creation, this company has been designing innovative and efficient concepts in terms of use, comfort and safety. Thanks to its revolutionary products, the FAUTRAS company has so far included nearly 90 innovation trophies at the Salon du Cheval in Paris and numerous awards such as the Innovation Prize at Equitana 2007 or the Coup de Cœur of Sustainable Development at the Salon du Cheval in Paris 2011. To date, the FAUTRAS plant, based in the heart of the Dordogne region, employs more than 70 people and can claim 100% French production in more than 50 retail stores in France and abroad.



• **De Buissy Stud Farm** - Thursday 10th May in the Afternoon

Created in the 95's, De Buissy Stud Farm is now one of the most renowned of the Anglo-Arab breed. Located in the heart of Corrèze, in Lubersac, close to the Château and the National Stud of Pompadour, Buissy was created thanks to Jean Bernard Anizan and Cendrine Dutrait. Buissy, a fervent believer in the purity of the Anglo-Arabian breed, has given birth to horses that have excelled at the highest level in all disciplines and have been exported to every corner of the world as :

- Looping of Buissy ICC 145
- Quotkijet of Buissy ICC 144
- Too Much of Buissy ICC 141
- Rock'n Roll of Buissy ICC 137; ISO 127
- Olala of Buissy ISO 165
- Shamdala of Buissy ISO 141
- Recto Verso of Buissy, exported to Morocco



Passionate about the Anglo-Arabs, Jean Bernard Anizan and Cendrine Dutrait purchased mares from the best strains of the breed such as: Jacinthe du Maury (mother of Fusain du Defey, ISO 162, stallion, Poemedamour de Buissy ISO 136, own brother of Buissy's Nid d'Amour, exported to the United States, CSO GP). Mares born at Buissy then sold have produced horses competing at the highest level such as :

- Mam'Zelle of Buissy (mother of Quenelle du Py, CSIO ISO 170)
- Ladybird of Buissy (mother of Rock'n Roll Animal ISO 140, standard: Vox Dei ISO 142)

Preservation of these pure Anglo-Arabian strains is of the highest importance as they are rare. That is why Buissy stud is only dedicated to breeding purebred horses in order to preserve an exceptional genetic heritage.

- **Presentation of Génétiqu'Anglo - Thursday 10th May in the Evening**

Aurélien Lafargue, President of Génétiqu'Anglo, will present this young associative structure created after the shutting down of the former « Haras Nationaux » (former national stud farm) in order to preserve the Anglo-Arab male genetic tracks collectively. A detailed presentation with videos of each stallion in the 2018 catalogue will be played and the day will be closed with a convivial dinner in the idyllic setting of Château de Pompadour.

- **SIRE-IFCE - Friday 11th May on the Morning**

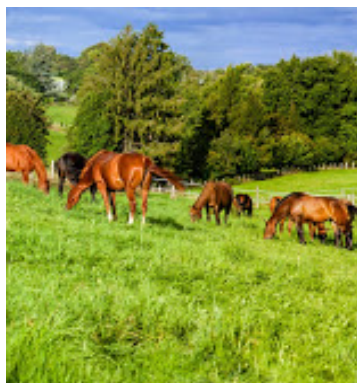
The equine information system (SIRE) is the central database referring to equine data on French territory. Beyond a real tool for the management of the equine civil status offering assistance in the selection and maintenance of zootechnical books, the SIRE is enriched to improve the health traceability of equidae. The French Horse and Equitation Institute (IFCE) is a public administrative institution under the authority of the ministries responsible for agriculture and sports. In 2010, originated by a merge of the National studs (haras nationaux) and the Ecole Nationale d'Equitation Cadre Noir of Saumur in 2010, IFCE has become the only operator of the equine sector.

- **Jumenterie Nationale de Pompadour (broodmares stud farm)**

Friday 11th May on the Morning

In these 80 hectares of meadows, foals practice racing and gambol under the amused and benevolent eyes of their mothers, with views of the Château de Pompadour and the Arnac's priory as decor.

La jumenterie nationale de Pompadour with sixty horses: Arabian Pur-Blood and Anglo-Arab sports and race breeds is the only national broodmares stud farm. This is the "maternity ward" of the Domaine de Pompadour where broodmares and foals are the center of attention. A special care is given to broodmares to have the best foaling conditions, and to foals to grow, flourish and acquire strength and vigor. At about six months of age, it is time for weaning: foals are separated from their mothers and males and females are separated into different groups. They will then carry on with education and training in community until the age of 2 and a half to 3 years.



The preservation of the Anglo-Arabian race in sporting lines is the priority for the Jumenterie Nationale de Pompadour. Pompadour center conserves and cultivates low strains which produced horses which have excelled in CSO and CCE in particular :

- Agence ISO 148 (mother of Asankhyeya ISO 138, Araguaia ISO 147)
- Eneide (mother of Eglefin ICC 144, Eternelle ISO 129, Encore une Médaille ICC 147)
- Nefta (mother of Mack of the Berlais ISO 152, Pak of Berlais ISO 149, Nadar ISO 127, Nuance de Reve ISO 141 ...)

- **Haras National of Pompadour (National stud)**

- Friday 11th May in the Afternoon**

Created under Louis XIV by Colbert to provide horses for the army, National studs closed during the revolution (1790) to open again with Napoleon the 1st in 1806. The National Stud of Pompadour became Royal Stud in 1761 under Louis XV thanks to the influence of his favorite: Madame de Pompadour. The initial mission of the National Stud changes over time, to adapt to the needs of the sector and socio-professionals. With more than 160 days of events per year, including 6 French championships and 3 international championships in 2017, Pompadour is a key place for riders but also for the public, for whom it is the first contact with the horse world.

The National Haras of Pompadour is indeed one of the highest place of equestrian events in France. Sport, of course, with high level equestrian competitions (Pompadour Grand Week, Grand National Eventing, CDI ***, ...) and 11 race days. It is also a hub for horses. The most beautiful example are the equestrian cabarets of summer whose performances take place in the legendary Orangerie, arranged for the occasion in a theater. Also organized in a spirit of promotion of the territory and of the heritage, visits (free and guided) are organized each day, brightened up by equestrian shows in season.

Finally, it is a place of training with the hosting of training courses and BPJEPS training courses. The aim is to set up on the Pompadour site and its surroundings, economic, social, sporting and cultural activities around the horse with a sustainable development approach.



- **Anglo Event - Saturday 12th May**

A trade of pure Anglo-Arab sports genetics is organized on Saturday May 12th, 2017 from noon. The aim of this sale is to gather fillies, yearlings, pouches of 2 years old and more as well as broodmares of pure Anglo-Arabian breed to offer them to a national and international clientele wishing to invest in an exceptional genetics and sought. Like a jewel in which the best horses meet, the Anglo Event is intended to be a professional and qualitative sale. It is for this reason that the proposed horses will be rigorously selected upstream.
